NOTE: Students in the Accounting (ACC) program must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better to remain in the program.

Students must successfully complete EAC149 before entering semester 3.

Students must be enrolled in EAC149, EAC150 or EAP500 before they can take BUS106 or MRK106

Students must successfully complete EAC150 before they can enter the fourth semester.

Students with a CPT test score indicating they require remedial math should take QNM103 in Semester 1 & QNM104 in Semester 2 (QNM103 + QNM104 = QNM106)
