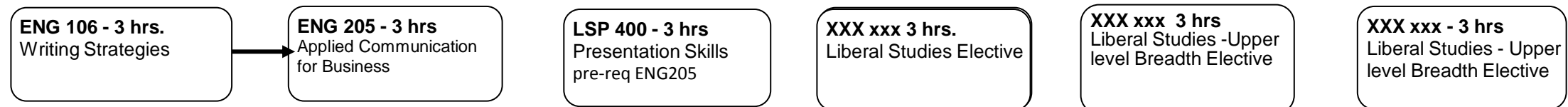

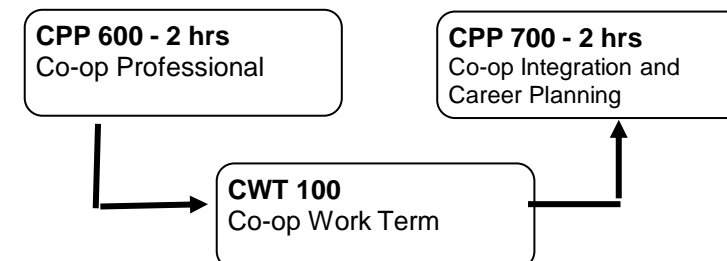

Students must successfully complete one Co-op Work Term to graduate and must take CPP600 prior to first work term and CPP700 immediately following the work term.



Two Liberal studies elective must be an upper level (300 or higher) course.
