- ~ Students in the Accounting (ACC) program must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or better to remain in the program.
- ~ All ACC students must take 2 General Education Options from two different areas of interest
- ~ Students must be enrolled in EAC149, EAC150 or EAP500 before they can take BAM101 OR MRK108
- ~ Students must successfully complete EAC150 before they can enter the fourth semester.
- ~ Students with a CPT test score indicating they require remedial math should take QNM103 in Semester 1 & QNM104 in Semester 2 (QNM103 + QNM104 = QNM106)
