ALL BAF STUDENTS:

ECN550 cannot be used as a General Education course in this program.

Students assessed at QNM103 for Math must take QNM103 in Semester 1 and QNM104 in Semester 2. (QNM103 + QNM104 = QNM106)

RFC121 and FIS403 must be completed before progressing to Semester 5.

Must obtain a minimum "C" in FIS 403 and EAC 594 and "B" in RFC 121 to be eligible for Semester 5, and must maintain a minimum 2.7 GPA to remain in the program.

Co-op Students:

To be eligible to apply for BAFC, students must achieve a minimum grade of "B" in RFC121 and a minimum grade of "C" in FIS403 and EAC394/EAC594.

To be eligible for BAFC Semester 5, students must complete ALL subjects from semesters 1-4 AND maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better.
