- ~ Students must successfully complete EAC150 before they can enter the fourth semester.
- ~ Students must be enrolled in EAC149, EAC150 or EAP500 before they can take BAM101 or MRK108
- ~ Students with a Skills Assessment score indicating they require QNM103 in Level 1 should take QNM104 in Level 2 (QNM103 + QNM104 = QNM106)
- ~ **A grade of "B" or better is required in ACC220 to proceed to ACC415.**
