- ~ Students with a Skills Assessment score indicating they require MTH158 should take MFB100 in Level 2

For General Education Requirements students must complete:
1 course from Arts & Humanities and 1 course from Sciences & Social Sciences
WTP100 is accepted as an equivalent to CAP500
