**Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) subjects: WTP100 (Work term preparation)/ACF331 Work term I/ACF332 Work term II)**

These subjects are only available to students who apply and are accepted into the ACF co-op stream having met the following academic eligibility requirements:

Prescribed curriculum up to date from sem. 1 to 3; minimum B grades in ACC120/220/431, COM101 and EAC594; minimum 3.0 GPA each term

~ Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better to remain in the program.

~ A grade of "B" or better is required in ACC220 to proceed to ACC415.

~ Students must successfully complete COM101 before they can enter the fourth semester.

~ Students must be enrolled in EAC149/EAP500 or, COM101 or EAP500 before they can take BAM101 or MRK108

~ Students with a Skills Assessment score indicating they require MTH158 should take MFB100 in Level 2

**For General Education Requirements students must complete:**

1 course from Arts & Humanities and 1 course from Sciences & Social Sciences

WTP100 is accepted as an equivalent to CAP500
